A drop dead gorgeous Saint Joseph that readers should snatch up is Yves's 2012 Saint Joseph, which has more in common with a Cote Rotie from the southern end of the appellation than your normal Saint Joseph. Perfumed, elegant and fragrant with classic raspberry, kirsch, olive paste, hints of bacon and flowers all soaring from the glass, this beauty is medium-bodied, graceful and elegant, with a core of sweet fruit that keeps you coming back to the glass. Already supple and approachable, I see no reason to delay gratification; nevertheless, it should have upwards of a decade of overall longevity. - JD
