2018 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Kabinett Feinherb  
Mosel, Germany

### **Score: 93 Points**

The 2018 Kabinett Feinherb from the Wehlener Sonnenuhr had also just been bottled ahead of Prowein. This is made from a parcel of vines that are eighty to one hundred years of age and comes in at just over ten percent octane, with 7.8 grams of acidity and twenty-two grams of sugar. The wine is pure and a beautifully classical expression of this lovely terroir, offering up scents of apple, pear, vanilla bean, salty, slate minerality, spring flowers and a whisper of wild yeasts. On the palate the wine is pure, medium-full, filigreed and superbly transparent, with fine complexity and bounce, bright acids and fine focus and grip on the poised and vibrant finish. Fine juice.
