The 2012 Macon Morizottes is a little delight. The bouquet is very attractive: fresh pear and touches of grapefruit and fresh melon at first, then later spicier scents emerge and add another layer of complexity. The palate is well-balanced, with plenty of citrus fruit, fresh apples and melon. There is impressive weight here and perhaps the precision is just taken down a couple of notches by warmth on the finish. Otherwise, this Macon Morizottes is packed full of flavor and should give drinking pleasure over the next 4 to 5 years.
