

## **Domaine J.L. Chave**

Hermitage Blanc 2018

Rhône Valley, France

### **Score: 96-97 Points**

2 Oct, 2019 – The thickness of the skins on Chave’s old vine parcels is what gives this wine its unrestricted depth and intensity, as well as its ability to age for a very long time. Aromas run from very pretty and floral, through peaches and lemons and into crushed and grilled nuts. The palate is such a textural essay with an attractively youthful and pithy shunt of tannin that underwrites a considerably long finish and long cellaring potential. Age and try from 2030.
