The 2015 Saint Joseph Le Clos comes from a single parcel of very old vines located south of Mauves that been resurrected by the Chave family. This is a beautiful, warmer terroir that's a mix of granite soils on the hillside and deeper, more sandy soils down on the valley floor. This killer wine is up with the best wines of the vintage and offers lots of kirsch and framboise, complex notes of bouquet garni, sweet, sweet tannin, and a full-bodied, seamless style that just begs to be drunk. It should be capable of lasting for two decades.
