The 2016 Juffer Kabinett Trocken from the Richter family is a lovely, delicate wine, coming in at eleven percent octane and carrying seven grams per liter of residual sugar. It offers up a fine bouquet of lime, apple, a fine base of slate, a touch of Brauneberg's gentle herb tones and a topnote of orange peel. On the palate the wine is crisp, fullish and nicely focused, with a good core, fine balance and grip, bright acids and excellent grip on the long and nascently complex finish. Good juice.
