The 2016 Pinot Noir Wendling Vineyard is quite youthfully reserved, unfurling in the glass with reticent aromas of ripe cherry and spice. On the palate, it's medium-bodied, with a deep core of fruit, a tangy line of acidity and rich, fine-grained structuring tannins: promising raw materials, but it's in need of 2 or 3 years of bottle age before it will reveal all its cards.
