Bright ruby-red. Raspberry, smoked meat and an iron nuance on the nose, lifted by a floral topnote. Tighter in the mouth than the other Chambolle cuvées here, but also in a rather atypically masculine, brooding style for Amoureuses. The dark raspberry and bitter chocolate flavors are firmed by a serious tannic spine. Not necessarily my idea of Amoureuses but the breadth and concentration of this wine suggest a bright future.

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
