One of my favorites in the Whitcraft range, the 2016 Pinot Noir Pence Ranch Pommard Clone wafts from the glass with a pretty nose of dried roses, violets, red berries, plums and a spicy top-note of cracked pepper. On the palate, the wine is light to medium-bodied, delicate and perfumed, with succulent acids and an open-knit, expansive profile. I'd be tempted to serve this at cellar temperature over the medium term. (WK)
