The 2017 Reserva Olho de Mocho is a 60/40 blend of Alicante Bouschet and Trincadeira aged for 16 months in new French oak. It comes in at 14% alcohol. Showing lovely mid-palate finesse and enlivening freshness, this follows on to provide fine flavor. A little sweet oak shows, but that will fade with time, overwhelmed by the fruit and structure. In regards to that structure, this is pretty intense, with fine power on the finish. This sophisticated red should age beautifully and acquire more complexity in time. This will certainly continue to improve over the next several years. (MS)
