From a parcel of 45-year-old vines that are farmed organically, the 2017 Chablis 1er Cru Fourneaux offers up a lovely bouquet of green apple, honeycomb, orange rind and dried white flowers. On the palate, it's medium to full-bodied, ample and layered, with a fleshy but well-defined core, concluding with a precise, delicately chalky finish. (WK)
