The name of the lieu dit. Schist and rosé granite here. Practically the only area that didn't get hailed – had to do a little green harvest to keep to about 45 hl/ha. Lovely purity of aroma – redcurrants – higher toned fruit in the mouth, almost a suggestion of pyrazine – in a good way. Almost blueberry in the finish – super clarity. Open, fresh, less cushioned than the first two. Excellent.
