Marsannay Blanc Cuvee Saint-Urbain 2014

Marsannay, Burgundy, France

The 2014 Marsannay Cuvée Saint-Urbain is a blend of 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Blanc aged in 500- and 600-liter Stockinger barrels for 12 months before being transferred into stainless steel. It has a crisp and taut bouquet with light flinty scents emanating from the Chardonnay, and a touch of hazelnut developing with time. The palate is clean and fresh on the entry, slightly waxy in texture with a hint of orange rind and white pepper towards the finish. Again, this is a very well-crafted white Marsannay that should drink well for 3-5 years. - NM
