Irancy “Mazelots” 2012

Burgundy, France

The 2012 Irancy Les Mazelots from David Renaud was showing just a slight reduction on the nose that required 2-3 minutes to blow off. The fruit here is a little darker than other Irancy '12s that I tasted, but still well defined with black cherries and red plum notes emerging, a touch of violet petal later. The palate is succulent on the entry, an Irancy that is more fruit-driven while maintaining fine tension and vigor. It fans out nicely on the finish with just a slight tinniness on the aftertaste. Very fine. –NM
