The outstanding 2009 Pouilly-Fuisse Les Petites Bruyeres possesses the texture, fullness and richness of a premier cru white Burgundy from the Cote d'Or. Aged completely in cement tanks, it exhibits lots of honeysuckle, orange rind, citrus oil, quince and honeysuckle characteristics. Full-bodied with loads of fruit and acidity, it should drink nicely for 2-3 years.
