Enough wood to notice and residual post-bottling sulfur renders the nose difficult to assess today. Otherwise though there is good freshness, size, weight and intensity to the bigger and richer flavors that also exude plenty of minerality and salinity onto the impressively long and complex finish. This is potentially really good juice that will definitely require several years of cellar time first.
