Leading off the reds, the traditional 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape offers textbook darker berry fruits as well as lots of dusty/sandy/loamy soil notes in a concentrated, voluptuous package that's going to keep for a decade. This cuvée is largely Grenache, yet includes 10% each of Mourvèdre and Syrah, as well as 10% other varieties. It's partially destemmed and aged in tank.
