Bright dark ruby-red. The fresh and fruity nose is complicated by notes of coffee and cocoa. Then slightly tough in the mouth, with noteworthy tannins providing structure and coating the palate dry. Finishes bright and saline with very good juiciness and a chunky quality. This is a blend of 40% Merlot, 40% Lagrein, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Teroldego; the Lagrein grows right next to the winery while the Merlot is planted on clay-rich soils around lake Garda (Lagrein does not fare well on clay, as the grapes fail to ripen and the wines never come around).
