The 2016 Mülheimer Helenenkloster Riesling Eiswein was picked on December 5th in incredibly healthy conditions, with just a bit of over-ripeness and botrytis (which is extremely rare, says Constantin Richter). The wine opens with clear, piquant, fresh and concentrated fruit on the nose. Clear and very delicate on the palate, this is a lush, highly finessed and well-balanced Eiswein with very fine and crystalline acidity, mineral grip and tension. This Eiswein is remarkably clear and lush but still finessed, precise, lean and elegant—in short, a beautiful Eiswein, the first since 2012. The corresponding two-starred Eiswein was made from 100% healthy grapes. (SR)
