Inky ruby. An array of fresh dark fruit and floral scents are complicated by suggestions of allspice and olive paste. Sweet and supple in the mouth, offering vibrant cassis and boysenberry flavors and a deeper licorice note that builds as the wine opens up. Emphatically fruity and surprisingly accessible; finishes very long and smooth with just a hint of tannins coming in late. (JR)
