There is a little more earthiness about the nose of the 2013 Saint Aubin 1er Cru Sur le Sentier du Clou compared to Colin's other premier crus, though with aeration it develops wilted petal scents, eases into its stride. The palate is underpinned by crisp acidity and tension, very citric in the mouth and more tightly coiled than Colin's other premier crus. Green apples and lemon zest furnish the finish of this Saint Aubin that has Puligny-like pretensions! Very fine. –NM
