Domaine de la Pousse d'Or

2014 Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Le Cailleret

Burgundy, France

This 1.8-acre parcel in Puligny came to the domaine when Patrick Landanger, the current proprietor of Pousse d'Or, purchased it from Domaine Jean Chartron in 2004, adding a prized terroir for whites to a domaine most noted for its reds. Fermented and aged in barrels (50 percent new), this is a wine with bold, gingery energy, packing its fair share of acidity into a savory, dark-toned white (if crème brûlée could be savory, it would taste like this). Youthful and intense, this is a grand wine that needs six to eight years of age to develop its inherent complexities.
