The 2013 Bourgogne Aligoté Champ Forey comes from 85-year-old vines, with a touch of Melon de Bourgogne. It has a very expressive bouquet with yellow flowers and dried apricot scents – both precise and vivacious. The palate is medium-bodied with hints of mango and apricot again, a keen thread of acidity and touch of hazelnut and quince on the finish. There is a digestif element about this Aligoté that is beguiling, completing what is an excellent Aligoté. -NM
