The 2016 Chablis 1er Cru Séchet is showing very well from bottle, unfurling in the glass with classy aromas of lemon oil, dried white flowers and oatmeal. On the palate, the wine is medium to full-bodied, glossy and deep, with superb concentration and chewy extract, framed by tangy acids. It's taut, pure and very classic in profile, and to my palate it's the finest of Billaud's 2016 premiers crus. (WK)
