The 2014 Chassagne-Montrache 1er Cru Vide Bourse has quite a Puligny-like, mineral-driven bouquet with scents of cold granite, sandstone and chalk, all extremely well defined. The palate is medium-bodied with a crisp line of acidity, precise and poised with a touch of shaved ginger towards the long and persistence finish. The best of Marc Colin's premier cru Chassagnes?
