Pur Pot 2014 Burgundy, France

The 2014 Pur Pot is a special selection of vines from Clos du Roy grown on particularly calcerous soils, and is matured 50% new oak; it includes 80% whole bunch fruit. It has superb fruit intensity on the nose with black cherries, cassis and raspberry coulis, with wonderful definition with an undertow of minerals emanating from the earth. The palate is medium-bodied, rounded and vivacious, with smoke-tinged black fruit with a very dense, concentrated finish that maintains superb delineation from start to finish. Give it 3-4 years in bottle before broaching. - NM
