At Templar Wine Cellars, traditional wine growing and production is a matter of honor, reverence and passion. It is a continuing tradition of experience from the Middle Ages. Their history is closely connected with the arrival of the Knights Templar in Čejkovice in the 1230s, and the first written record of their activity is dated to 1248. Together with a Templar stronghold, vast wine cellars were built, the likes of which were not seen in this land before. Located in the Moravia region of the Czech republic, this area is the focus of a recent resurgence in quality. Sharing a border with northern Austria, this cool climate lends itself to high quality wines, and Templar Cellars is proud to represent this up-and-coming area.
