Always one of the high points of the range chez Fagot, the 2018 Bourgogne Blanc Les Champs l'Huillier has turned out well, mingling hints of citrus oil and white flowers with aromas of ripe pear and almond paste. Medium to full-bodied, fleshy and lively, it's the more tensile and concentrated of the two Bourgogne bottlings. (89 points)
