Chablis 1er Cru “Mont de Milieu” 2013
Burgundy, France

The 2013 Chablis 1er Cru Montée de Tonnerre comes from two parcels and sees 20% oak aging, a majority from the Chassin cooperage. The nose is very expressive, riper than the Mont de Milieu with grilled almond and hints of vanilla soaring from the glass. This is a Chablis that is exotic and generous. The palate is tender on the entry with orange peel and hints of apricot, very approachable, but with appreciable length as it gently fans out. Excellent stuff from Samuel Billaud. – ST
