The 2017 Marsannay P'tite Grumotte is a special selection of millerandé grapes that were frosted last year. You would mistake the nose for a Gamay if you had this blind - just like a Moulin-à-Vent. The palate is well balanced with supple blueberry and red cherry fruit, smooth texture and an intense, confit-like black olive finish. Very fine. (NM)
