From lithe gray slate soil in a southwest-facing vineyard in a side valley of the Mosel, the 2017 Mülheimer Sonnenlay Riesling Kabinett Feinherb is very fine and floral on the flinty nose, with herbal (oregano and marjoram) notes and delicate ripeness. Exciting! On the palate, this is a dense, lush and intense yet delicate, fresh and mineral Riesling with a very long, piquant, intense, firmly structured and salty finish. Bottled in March 2018 and tasted a year later. This is an excellent Kabinett with 10.5% alcohol. **(SR)**
