Deep magenta. Spice-accented cherry and dark berry scents are complemented by suggestions of espresso, licorice and cracked pepper. Lively and focused on the palate, offering bitter cherry, black currant and dark chocolate flavors sharpened by a jolt of spicy cracked pepper. Finishes taut and lively, with a repeating cherry note and gentle tannic grip. (90 points)
