Pascal Laffourcade's 2009 Savennieres is a value-priced beauty (many Savennieres are priced over \$30 a bottle) offering chalky minerality intermixed with melon, honey and underripe white peach notes. Medium-bodied, crisp, dry and refreshing, it should drink nicely for 3-4 years. I have previously written about the brilliance of the 100% Chenin Blanc dry whites from Savennieres, which remain reasonably priced, under-the-radar wines.
