Made from a blend of 75% Syrah and 25% Grenache, the 2011 Cuvee Anna Rouge [exhibits](#) black fruit notes along with a smoky, grilled herbaceousness that is very endearing, medium to full body, and a plump, fleshy character. It is best consumed over the next 2-3 years. This ancient Costieres de Nimes estate was founded in 1654 as part of an ecclesiastical order.
