



2011 Herdade Do Rocim Reserva Olho de Mocho

A proprietary blend dry Red Table wine from Alentejano, Alentejo, Portugal

The 2011 Reserva Olho de Mocho red is a blend of 40% Alicante Bouschet, 30% Touriga Nacional and 30% Syrah, coming in at 14.5% alcohol. It was aged in used French oak for 16 months. Revisited this issue for a checkup, this is evolving beautifully. The oak has begun to be absorbed, although that process still continues, and it shows more focus in its relatively muscular fashion. A more complete wine now, it is right on track, its parts integrating better and the wine ever more impressive. Rocim had a fine 2011 vintage. – MS
