2015 Saint-Joseph

Alluring, cutting a broad swath, as velvety textured cassis, plum and blackberry puree flavors move through, infused with warm anise, black tea and mesquite notes. The mouthwatering acidity is well-buried through the finish, lending this somewhat weighty wine a mouthwatering character *(95 points)*

2015 Saint-Joseph “Offerus”

Intense, with a racy graphite edge driving the core of crushed plum and cherry fruit along. Dried anise, fruitcake and black tea notes run along the edges, adding range and texture. *(93 points)*
