Inky ruby. Spice-tinged dark berry and cherry aromas are complemented by suggestions of olive, candied licorice and pungent flowers. Supple, appealingly sweet black and blue fruit flavors gain depth with air while a smoky mineral element adds lift and cut. Velvety tannins add gentle grip to a very long, floral-driven finish that leaves a subtle star anise note behind. (92 points)
