This 5,500-bottle release displays a blend of fruit limited to the comune (or village) of Barolo at the heart of the appellation. The Virna 2016 Barolo del Comune del Barolo casts a wide net of aromas, with lots of deep, dark plummy aromas that emerge with a noticeable level of openness and accessibility. This is a loosely knit Barolo with soft tannins and generous fruit, spice, tar and licorice on the finish. This is a solid near or medium-term drinking option that soon could serve as your go-to dinner party wine. (ML)
