By the time it was filtered, there were a mere 20 liters of this elixir. Pear and quince preserves are mingled with caramel and overlain with haunting scents of white truffle, stale white bread and white raisin, each a distinctive reflection of dominant botrytis. The confitured concentration of a glossy, expansive palate is enhanced by honey-like richness but also leavened by an unexpected influx of fresh pineapple and pink grapefruit that lends animation and a modicum of sheer refreshment to a superbly sustained finish.
