**Santenay Vieille Vignes Champs Claude 2014**

The 2014 Santenay Vieille Vignes Champs Claude, from 110-year-old vines, delivers a "cool" nose with dark cherry and faint marine scents that gently unfold. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, not terribly complex but harmonious and fresh, with a hints of white pepper lending a spicy touch to the laid-back finish. Probably more early drinking than the Saint Aubin 1er Cru, nevertheless it will give 3-6 years of Pinot pleasure. -NM
