Brilliant yellow. Mineral-accented aromas of poached pear, nectarine, vanilla and honey carry a gingery overtone. Round, expansive orchard and pit fruit flavors pack a solid punch and gain sweetness and a smoky nuance with air. The smooth, subtly warm finish clings with good tenacity and resonating honey and spice notes. In an ample style that calls for equally rich, full-flavored food. (JR)
