Veldenzer Elisenberg Riesling Kabinett 2015 Mosel, Germany

Coming from quartzite soils, the 2015 Veldenzer Elisenberg Riesling Kabinett is one of the most beautiful Kabinett Rieslings I have tasted from this vintage along Saar and Mosel. The nose is super clear and smoky, indicating a light and fine but complex Riesling. Lush and racy on the palate, this is a firmly structured, pure and piquant Kabinett with lots of stones and minerals on the palate and a long, complex finish. This wine is clear as a mountain stream, and its sweetness of 54 grams of residual sugar is almost completely swallowed by the pure and flinty minerality. The finish is salty and highly piquant. This is simply great Riesling coming along as a picture book Kabinett. Sensational price! - SR
