Translucent yellow-gold. Ripe Meyer lemon, pear and jasmine scents show very good clarity and pick up suggestions of tarragon and smoky minerals with air. Pliant and broad on the palate, offering lush citrus and orchard fruit flavors and a deeper nectarine nuance that gains strength on the back half. Shows very good clarity and mineral cut on the finish, which features a gently sweet honey element. (92 points)
