Blended from Bassenon, Tupin and Collet, the 2016 Cote Rotie represents the soft elegance of the southern end of Côte Rôtie. Bay leaf and raspberry notes appear on the nose, while the medium-bodied palate is silky and delicate, marked by hints of tea leaves and red berries. (JC)
