The 2017er Riesling Richter Estate is made from Estate holdings of young vines in the Erdener Herrenberg, Graacher Domprobst and Himmelreich as well as parcels in Mülheim. It was fermented down to fully off-dry levels at 30 g/l of residual sugar. The wine delivers a nicely fruity and ripe nose of yellow peach, plum, earthy spices, smoke and a hint of tar. It unfolds good presence yet remains light-footed on the just off-dry palate. Some nicely tickly acidity whips up the flavors right into the focused, light and long finish.
