Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Spätlese Trocken “Uralte Wurzelechte Reben” 2014  
Mosel, Germany

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### **Score: 90 Points**

From a plot named In Brück that was planted in 1890, the 2014 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Spätlese trocken Uralte Wurzelechte Reben was picked with 91° Oechsle and fermented to 11.5% alcohol. The wine opens deep, ripe and intense on the nose, and displays ripe and stewed peaches on the nose. On the palate this is a juicy, rich and intense Riesling with good mineral structure and grip. This is a traditional, dry Riesling whose grapes were macerated for about six hours. Very good aging potential. - SR
