The 2013 Santenay Vieilles Vignes Champs Claude is slightly deeper in color than Colin’s other reds. It has a fragrant and quite floral bouquet that opens beautifully in the glass, maintaining impressive purity. The palate is very well balanced with fine tannins and very well-judged acidity. This is very pure, almost Gevrey-like with great precision on the finish. This is well worth looking out for. –NM
