Inky ruby. Expressive, spice-accented cherry and blackberry aromas are complemented by suggestions of smoky minerals, olive and pungent flowers. Fleshy and vibrant on the palate, offering sappy dark berry, cherry cola and violet pastille flavors and a hint of candied violet. Lively and appealingly sweet on the broad, persistent finish, which features well-knit tannins and resonating florality. (93 points)
