Pinot Noir “Fog Eater” 2014
Anderson Valley, California

This is Jason Drew’s entry-level pinot noir; the 2014 is a blend of fruit from Morning Dew Ranch (Anderson Valley), Perli and Valenti (Mendocino Ridge) and Weir (Yorkville Highlands), all aged in neutral oak. It’s rustic, a bit raw in its tannins, yet very refreshing—a woody pinot noir with bracing acidity running through flavors of dark cherry and menthol.
