PROFILE

Founded in 1970 by Marc Colin and his wife Michele, Domaine Marc Colin now spans 15 hectares encompassing 26 appellations in Saint-Aubin, Chassagne, Puligny, and Santenay. Most of the land was inherited from past generations of the Colin and Ponavoy families; certain parcels have been in the family for more than 100 years. While the family does own prime territory in Chassagne, home base in Saint-Aubin features parcels of the very best vineyards, En Remilly and Chatenière, to name a few. Today Caroline and Damien, two children of Marc and Michele, own and run the domaine.

The premier cru vineyard of Les Chenevottes sits slightly higher up the slope from the grand cru Montrachet. Chenevottes shares a similar soil composition, exposure to the sun, and orientation with Montrachet. Les Chenevottes is derived from the word cheneve, which translates to “hemp” in old French, which indicates that this vineyard was once an old hemp field.
